According to documents this day presented to our Office we hereby certify on behalf of the Estonian Committee in Sweden that Mr. Olaf AULE, Estonian citizen, born on Nov. 22, 1913, in Tartu, Estonia, having gone through the compulsory six years' elementary school training completed, in 1931, the full course of J. WESTHOLM's PRIVATE GRAMMAR SCHOOL (Gymnasium) in Tallinn, which was an acknowledged secondary school in Estonia. At this school he had been instructed in the belowmentioned subject-matters each for a correspondingly stated number of semesters (1 semester=17 weeks) and weekly amount of lessons:
