STAGE 1: Introduction (max 2 minutes)

[Greet the candidate and ask him/her to sit down.]

Good morning/afternoon.

The interview is recorded.

[Switch on the recorder.]

Let's talk about singing. How popular is singing as a hobby among young people? (Why?) Would it be a good idea to have singing as a career? (Why?)

OR

Let's talk about online shopping. Have you ever bought anything online? (Explain.) What are some of the advantages of online shopping? (Explain.)

Thank you. Let's go on to task 1.

In this task, I would like you to compare and contrast 2 pictures. You should speak for 2 minutes. Before you talk, you have 1 minute to think about what you are going to say. You cannot make any notes.

Please, pick a card.

What is the number of your card?
