Dear Mr. Saluveer,

Thank you for your letter of
July 3. I am sorry not to have followed up ear-
lier on my letter of February 7 after the meet-
ing of the Executive Committee at the end of
May.

Your letter was discussed by
the Committee, each member of which had copies
in the appropriate language. After a detailed
study the Executive felt that the position taken
in my earlier letter to the effect that your
Federation did not fall within either of the
categories entitled to Assembly assistance was
a correct one. They did not feel that it was
possible in any case to apply organisations of
teachers in exile the same provisions as
applied to national teachers organisations with-
in the countries concerned.

I appreciate that this reply will
not be very satisfying to you but I hope that
you will be able to explain the position to your
colleagues.
