TO VICOTP FULL MEMBER ORGANISATIONS

Dear Colleagues:

Subject: Membership dues 1982

WCOTP membership dues for 1982 are due to be paid to the Confederation as of January I and according to the Bylaws by June 30 at the latest. Recognising the cash flow problems of member organisations, the Finance Committee recommended, and the Assembly accepted, that dues may be paid in three parts - one-third by March 1, a further one-third by May 1 and the balance by June 30.

The 1980 Assembly adopted the recommendation proposed by the Finance Committee that the per capita fee for 1982 be set at 80 Swiss centimes. Therefore full member organisations are due to pay either:

a fixed rate of 80 Swiss centimes per individual member for full member organisations in countries in which the initial annual salary of a qualified primary teacher is more than 10,000 times the fixed rate of dues, i.e. more than SwF 8,000 in the case of 1982 (eight thousand Swiss francs).

or

a proportional rate of 1/10,000 part of the initial salary 2. of a qualified primary teacher per individual member for full member organisations in countries in which the initial annual salary of a qualified primary teacher is less than 10,000 times the fixed rate of dues, i.e. less than SwF 8,000 in the case of 1982 (eight thousand Swiss francs).

The operation of this system may be illustrated by two examples:

- With an initial annual salary of a qualified primary teacher of SwF 9,000 per year, an organisation with 15,000 members would pay 15,000 x SwF 0.80 (the fixed rate) = SwF 12,000.
- With an initial annual salary of a qualified primary teacher of SwF 5,000, an organisation with 15,000 members would pay 15,000 x SwF 0.50 = SwF 7,500.

All full member organisations are due to pay their dues at the fixed rate of 80 Swiss centimes unless they present to the Finance Committee a statement of their full dues-paying membership and evidence of the initial annual salary of a qualified primary teacher in the form of a schedule of salary rates issued by the employing authority or a statement of the initial salary rate from the employing authority. In the case of varying rates of salary, as in a federal system of education, the member organisation concerned may submit a statement proposing a weighted average figure for acceptance by the Finance Committee.

Payments are to be made in Swiss francs and paid either by cheque or by bank transfer to the WCOTP account No. 544.145 at the Swiss Bank Corporation, 1110 Morges, Switzerland. Please use the enclosed form.

Implications for Assembly assistance - travel

As for 1980, the new system of assistance for attendance at the Assembly of Delegates will operate for 1982 in the cases of: (a) those full member organisations which pay at the 1/10,000th proportional rate, and (b) full member organisations in countries with a national population of less than one million inhabitants. This assistance will be available as long as the budget provision of SwF 120,000 (for 1982) lasts on the basis of one grant covering travel to the Assembly at the most economic rate possible per country. In cases where there is more than one member organisation in a country to which either of these provisions applies, the grant will be either divided among the eligible organisations (if the organisations agree) or given over a period of years proportional to membership. For example, in a country with two organisations, one with 10,000 members and the other with 5,000, the grant may be divided two-thirds/one-third or will be available for two years to the larger organisation and in the third year to the smaller.

In order to be eligible to claim travel assistance, a full member which falls in either of these two categories must have paid its 1981 and 1982 membership dues in full. Thus early settlement of payment is encouraged because when the fund of SwF 120,000 has been used no further grants will be available. I might add that in past years this fund has been sufficient to meet the demand.

These grants cover <u>travel</u> only to the site of the Assembly. Organisations benefitting from these will be expected to pay the Assembly registration fee and the stay costs of their delegate. These costs were given in the letter of invitation to the Assembly which was mailed in December.
