The boy-scout group "Kalev" in Stockholm, Sweden, one of the very first units to be founded in exile, is celebrating its 25th anniversary this year. During its existence over a thousand boys have been brought up according to scouting principles. Many of them are now to be found in different parts of the world, and a considerable number of them have reached responsible positions in the life of their respective countries of residence.

The membership of the boy-scout group "Kalev" is at present about fifty, among them several boys whose fathers in their time have been numbered in its ranks. They continue to bear these good scouting traditions which have given "Kalev" its good reputation both in the scouting movement and among the Estonian communities all over the world.
